The Alliance for Young Artists & Writers engages in partnerships with institutions of higher education across the country to encourage additional scholarship opportunities for recipients of The Scholastic Art & Writing Awards. The institutions listed below offer scholarships to Scholastic Art & Writing Award recipients who are seniors in high school.

The Association of Independent Colleges of Art and Design (AICAD)

The Association of Independent Colleges of Art and Design (AICAD) is a consortium of leading art schools in the U.S. AICAD and the Alliance for Young Artists and Writers have partnered to offer scholarships to recipients of The Scholastic Art Awards who are seniors in high school, and who have applied and been accepted to AICAD member institutions. AICAD member institutions offer scholarships in the following amounts and categories:

1. Portfolio Gold Award Recipients in General Art and Photography
\$1,500 per year for 4 years or \$7,500 for the first year;
2. Portfolio Silver Award Recipients in General Art and Photography
\$1,000 per year for 4 years or \$5,000 for the first year;
3. Gold Award Recipients who are Seniors in high school
\$250 per year for 4 years or \$1,500 for the first year

These are minimum scholarship requirements and any AICAD member institution may offer higher amounts, or provide additional scholarships to a nationally recognized Scholastic Art Award recipient. AICAD member institutions are indicated below with asterisks (*).
