About this Special Achievement Award:

The One Earth Award, underwritten by an anonymous donor, provides four students whose creative works encourage the awareness of, and meaningful responses to, pressing issues of climate change with \$1,000 scholarships. In addition, special awards are also available for students from Virginia, North Carolina, South Carolina, and Georgia.

What is climate change?

Climate change refers to significant changes in global temperature, precipitation, wind patterns, and other measures of climate that occur over several decades or longer. It has numerous ecological impacts, including species extinction and habitat loss, food systems, water resources, and declining ecosystems.

Works by artists and writers advance our thoughts, reflections and understanding of solutions, and improve awareness of individual actions that we can take to reduce harm and slow the destruction of planetary resources.

About the Scholastic Art & Writing Awards:

For nearly a century, the Scholastic Art & Writing Awards have recognized the vision, ingenuity, and talent of our country's youth.
